

BYLAWS OF UNITED SUDANESE YOUTH

ARTICLE I: DESIGNATION

This organization shall be known as the *United Sudanese Youth*

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

United Sudanese Youth shall be none profit organization and their aims and purposes are:

- a. To help develop train young Sudanese leaders principled leadership and encourage a unified vision for brighter and peaceful Sudan.
- b. To bring unity among all Sudanese Youth.
- c. To provide the Sudanese youth with the opportunity to practice the principles of democratic procedures.
- d. To develop sound programs of social, civic and cultural activities for the benefit all young Sudanese.
- e. Encourage involvement in higher learning and higher education.

ARTICLE III: ORGANIZATION

United Sudanese Youth shall consist of eligible members. Members shall be eligible to serve on committees established by the board of directors or the commissioner of the purpose of advising or assisting in the carry out of the purpose of the organization. Members shall be eligible for election to the executive offices of the USY.

Any member of the USY shall be subject to suspension of dismissal from the membership if they should fail to conduct themselves in the commonly accepted manner.

ARTICLE IV: MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 qualifications Membership in United Sudanese Youth shall be confine to benefit of the society by birth or descendant. The USY will not discriminate against any individual based on the color, religion, gender or national origin, as long as the individual fully supports and adhere to the purpose as prescribed in Article II.

Section 2 Dues Admission fee or membership dues shall be required of any member for his/her admission in United Sudanese Youth. Contribution shall include, but shall not be limited to be payments provided space for meetings or conferences.

Section 3 Application Admission in United Sudanese Youth must be obtained application in the forms provided by the USY. All applications of participant members must be sent to secretary of the USY.

Section 5 Participation. Participation in the meetings of the USY leaders shall not be limited.

Section 6 Annual Conferences

- a. The USY shall have Annual Conference once a year. The program provided

by the USY councils shall regulate their activities. The annual Conference of USY shall be held at any convenient time and place.

- b. Participation. The participation in the USY in the Annual meeting shall not be limited to its members and the delegates duly elected by the USY councils on the basis hereinafter provided.
- c. The ruling of the boards of directors shall provide delegate annually. To qualify for nomination and election as a delegate, the member must be a member of the USY council.
- d. Domination of Delegate. The delegate shall be nominated and elected at the meeting of the council held at least 60 days preceding the Annual Conference.
- e. Conference Conduct The delegates to the Conference shall not engage in any social activities that may exclude the participation of any delegate in Attendance, nor engage in any misconduct that would diminish the image of USY.
- f. Conference Meeting. During the Conference, the delegates shall review the progress made during the preceding year and formulate programs to be carried out by the Council.

ARTICLE V: Administration

Section 1 Composition. The USY administration shall consist of a special committee composed of the chair of USY directors. This committee shall be charged with the responsibility of supervision, coordination, and development of the organization and as such shall be responsible to the board of directors.

Section 2 Board of directors. Board of directors shall manage the organization. The term of directors shall be determined by member of organization for their respective seat on the board, and until a successor is elected, or pointed, and qualified. They shall administer and supervise the activities of the USY assigned to them in accordance with the provisions of these by-laws and the boards of the USY for their respective organization may approve such other rules or programs as.

ARTICLE VI: OFFICERS

Section 1 Administrative officers. The USY shall have the following officers. President, vice president, secretary, treasurer, and trustees.

Section 2 Election of Administrative Officers. A nominating committee composed of five members, appointed by the President, shall nominate the Officer. It shall be the duty of the nominating committee to nominate one or more members for each office for which elections are being held. After the nominations of the committee have been placed before the members, the president shall call for nomination from the floor. At the closing of the nominations, the election of the Officers shall be made by secret ballot. The nominee or the nominees who shall receive the highest number of votes shall be thereby elected. No person shall hold more than one position at any level, whether elected or appointed. All Officers shall serve two (2) year terms. Treasure shall be elected in odd numbered years by majority vote of the board of directors. The secretary shall be elected in even numbers by majority vote of board of directors.

Any Officer elected or appointed by the board of directors may be removed by a three fourths (3/4) vote of the board of directors whenever in its judgment the best interest of the organization shall be served thereby.

A vacancy in any officer because of resignation, disqualification or otherwise may be filled by a majority vote of the board of directors for the unexpired portion of the term.

The executive Officer shall be responsible for the enforcement of organization policies established by the board of directors. They shall have authority to address any violation and impose any appropriate behavior.

Section 3 Duties of the President. The President shall represent the USY at public function and preside at the annual Conference of the USY and administration meetings and shall perform any other duties and responsibilities authorized by the boards of directors.

Section 4 Duties of the Vice-President. The Vice-President shall take the place of the President when the president is unable to act.

Section 5 Duties of Secretary shall handle correspondence and documentation of the organization. The secretary will also keep the minutes of the organization and board meetings.

Section 6 Duties of Treasure The Treasure shall control the funds of the organization, have charge, custody of, and be responsible for all funds and securities of the organization. It shall be the function of the treasure to prepare an annual budget for board approval. Treasure reports shall be prepared and presented at each board meeting for approval by the board of directors. All funds received for organization must be deposited in the name of the organization on such bank.

Section 7 duties of Trustee. The Trustee shall have those duties assigned to them by the president.

ARTICLE VII: ELECTION

A majority vote will constitute election. Voting rights shall be allocated among members as follows. Each member organization shall be entitled to one (1) vote. The secretary and treasurer will determine election results immediately.

ARTICLE VIII: QUORUM

Business may be conducted at any meeting of the executive Officers when a majority is present. Notification of all meetings must have a minimum of 7 days written notice.

The USY leaders shall meet once a month and their activities must be supervised by the USY Director and committees appointed for that purpose. No member of the Youth council shall interfere with the orderly progress of the meeting by leaving his/her seat or engaging in unnecessary conversation. Any member guilty of any unprofessional conduct

shall be reported to USY council maybe temporarily removed until further action taken by board.

ARTICLE IX: RULES

All meetings shall be run in accordance with the organization rules.

ARTICLE X: AMENDMENT

These by-laws may be amended at any business meeting by a vote of two third (2/3) of the organization members present provided by the amendment has been submitted in writing at the previous business meeting or in writing to each member thirty (30) days prior to the meeting.

ARTICLE XI: USE OF FUNDS AND ASSETS

The funds and assets of the organization shall be used solely for the purpose of the organization as set in article 2 of these bylaws. No part of the organization's funds may be used for propaganda or influence of politic. No such funds, assets, and earning of the organization shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any member, director, officer, or other official of the organization. The organization may be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services.
